BSc (Hons) Nursing Studies / Registered Nurse (Adult) Apprenticeship Programme



About the Programme

The Health Academy at Lancashire Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust are working in partnership with Northumbria University to deliver a full time nursing degree. This is delivered using an 18 month route, leading to a BSc (Hons) Nursing Studies / Registered Nurse (Adult) Apprenticeship Programme that has been validated by the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC). This programme currently is only open to staff wishing to work in the field of Adult Nursing. The course is full time and is a mix of clinical and academic study. Your time will be split between academic study and clinical placements.

Placements

As a student you will have your entire placement opportunities provided at a local NHS Trust. You will benefit from professional mentorship, excellent multidisciplinary resources and broad learning opportunities that are well established within the Trust.

Salary & Benefits

As this is an apprenticeship your course fees will be paid in full which enables you to qualify without any student debt. You will be paid an apprentice salary for the first 12 months and minimum wage for your final 6 months on programme. Once you complete this programme and receive your NMC pin number you will be able to commence in a band 5 position.

Duration: 18 Months

Entry Requirements: English Language and Mathematics at GCSE or Functional Skills, Maths and English at level 2. PLUS a Foundation Degree in a healthcare related subject, evidence of learning through healthcare practice experience equivalent to 50% of the three year programme AND confirmation of programme eligibility via their employer.
