

# Immediate Life Support Instructor Course (ILSi)



ILSi is not open to applications in the same way our other courses are.

Instead, our future Instructors are found when they're Candidates on one of our ILS courses. Our Course Directors and Faculty identify Candidates who they feel would make excellent Instructors and recommend them as having Instructor potential (IP). Those Candidates then receive a letter inviting them to book a place on an ILSi course.

The only way to take an ILSi course is to be recommended as a Candidate with Instructor Potential (IP) while attending an ILS course.

If you are recommended, we will send you an invitation to take a course. Once you've opted in to taking an ILSi course, we will provide you with the next steps and what you need to do.

ILSi teaches the knowledge and skills required to:

- understand the nature of teaching and learning;
- understand the needs of individual learners;
- understand the awareness of the four domains of learning;
- undertake the various types of teaching sessions on the provider courses.

ILSi must be taken within one year of the date of the provider course.

All of our Course Centres are approved and certified by Resuscitation Council UK. Courses are run by dedicated and qualified Instructors, who have taken an RCUK Instructor course to guarantee that our courses are uniform and the content remains the same across our Course Centres.
