Details of type of clients being dealt with:	Adults (16 and over) presenting with a variety of traumatic orthopaedic conditions. RPH is a Major Trauma Centre accepting complex patients from a wide geographical area
The type of experience which may be gained from this placement:	<ul> <li>Working as part of the MDT/core therapy team</li> <li>Working as part of the Integrated Rehab Team – specialising in hip fractures.</li> <li>Management of complex trauma</li> <li>Functional assessment including PADLs, DADLs and cognition.</li> <li>Discharge planning – including onward referral</li> <li>Use of rehabilitation approach incorporating compensatory and biomechanical models</li> <li>Ordering assistive equipment using the retail model</li> <li>General understanding of record keeping, consent, time</li> </ul>
