
Dear Colleague,

I would like to invite you to take part in a short survey for an Urgent Public Health COVID study. UK-REACH is a UK-wide study looking into the disparities in the way people have been affected by Covid-19.



It aims to explore how ethnicity may affect COVID-19 outcomes across the UK, and the impact of the pandemic on healthcare workers. Recommendations from the study will help to inform future public health initiatives.

Who can take part?

All health care workers across all our trusts departments can take part, including those in ancillary roles (porters, catering, security and administrative staff). We particularly encourage those from an ethnic minority background. The aim of the study is to understand if, how, and why, ethnicity affects COVID-19 diagnosis and clinical outcomes in people who work in healthcare settings. It is entirely voluntary, and you can answer questions at your own discretion. Any answers you give will be anonymised and not shared with LTHTR.
