### Referencing

You should use the Harvard referencing style to format your references. Follow the examples below. References should be organised alphabetically by author surname at the end of your document. If you need help, contact the Clinical Librarians on extension 4763.

#### Please note:

All references should start with: first author's surname, initial.  $\rightarrow$  Dimond, B. More than two authors: first author's surname, initial. et al  $\rightarrow$  Dimond, B. et al
