What is NICE Evidence Search?

Evidence Search is a web based portal that provides free open access to a unique index of authoritative health and social care evidence-based information. Drawing on local, national and international sources it will simultaneously search over 300,000 resources from hundreds of trustworthy and accredited sources.

Use Evidence Search to find freely accessible guidelines, reports, policy documents, etc. (i.e. anything that is not a journal article).


How do I access NICE Evidence Search?

Evidence Search Homepage - Simple Search

Simply type in your **key-words** and click on the search button and magnifying glass

If you are looking for **journal articles**, click on this link to access **databases** such as **Medline, Embase and Cinahl**. You will need an **NHS Athens** username and password. See our library guide

Filter your results by area of interest, evidence type, sources, or publication date

Sort results by relevancy or publication date

Click on the **title** to access the document

Find **publication details** such as **date** and **source**

At the bottom of the page you can **navigate** through the results by clicking '**Next**' and change **how many results** are shown per page.
