The Lancashire simulation centre has a custom built suite within the Royal Preston Hospital. With a team of friendly, knowledgeable and approachable staff, we aim to make the training enjoyable and relaxed. We pride ourselves on our ability to provide an immersive and interactive educational experience. The team achieves this through the use of a range of high fidelity wireless manikins from neonate and paediatric to adult males and our new birthing manikin Lucina. Adding in realism with moulage, appropriate equipment and ourselves as actors/actresses within the sessions. We also use video analysis debrief to allow candidates to observe and learn from their own behaviours, situational awareness and decision making skills.

Although most of the team have a clinical background, alongside the clinical aspects of the scenarios our main focus is looking at the human factors and non-technical skill elements. With the aim of trying to improve patient safety through awareness of human error and how it can be prevented.

SIMULATED TRAUMA TRAINING COURSE

This one day practical trauma training course involves theory presentations, interactive workshops and trauma scenarios within a high fidelity simulation centre. The course is designed and is appropriate to serve as an introduction to the management of trauma for emergency department nurses, operating department practitioners, paramedics and major trauma ward nurses.

Course Content Covers:

- Kinematics and mechanism of injury
- Human factors and non-technical skills
- Airway Management
- Chest injury recognition and assessment
- Circulatory assessment and shock
- EZIO
- Pelvic splints and use of tourniquets
- Head injury recognition and assessment
- Spinal injury management and awareness

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SAFE CRITICALLY ILL TRANSFER TRAINING
