


LibKey Nomad

Why use LibKey Nomad



LibKey Nomad is a browser extension that automatically provides links to the full text articles subscribed to by the Library Service, while you search the web.

- Makes it easier to access journals
- Saves you time
- Works with you as you search the web
- Provides you with easy access to our document delivery service.




How to download LibKey Nomad using Edge

1. Click on the **Setting and More (...)** menu in the top right hand corner Edge and choose Extensions. In the pop up box that appears click **Open Microsoft Edge Add-ons**




You will be taken to the following Edge Add-ons website. Search for LibKey Nomad and choose the option when shown.

Click on Get to install **LibKey Nomad**




A popup box will appear, click **Add extension**



Choose your organisation

Next, you will be asked to select your organization. Start to type in Lancashire Teaching Hospitals and select Lancashire Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust.

You should now be able to use LibKey Nomad



Using LibKey Nomad

Journal articles

As you browse the web you will see the icon shown opposite when there is an option to access a journal article. Click on this icon and you will be taken to the full text article (when available) or our article request form.



PubMed

As you search PubMed you will see icons similar to the icons shown opposite. Again these will direct you to the full text article or the library's ILL form.




Managing LibKey Nomad

You can disable LibKey Nomad by going to the Setting and more (...) menu in the top right hand corner of Edge and choosing Extensions.

A dialog box will appear: choose Manage extensions



Move the slider shown to the left to disable LibKey Nomad



To enable LibKey Nomad, just move the slider back to the right.

DynaMed is a clinical point of care tool that aims to help clinicians overcome information overload. You will not need a username and password to access DynaMed while working from a Trust device. For home access you will need your OpenAthens username and password. You can [register](#) here for your OpenAthens account.

World Heart Rhythm Week 6th – 12th June

World Heart Rhythm Week is an annual event which will run between the 6th – 12th June in 2023. This is organised by the Arrhythmia Alliance, a coalition of patients, charities and professionals who work together to promote effective diagnosis and treatment of heart arrhythmia (a disorder affecting the rhythm of the heartbeat). The aim of World Heart Rhythm Week is to raise awareness of the symptoms of heart arrhythmia in both the public and medical profession. Diabetes Week 12th – 18th June

Diabetes U.K. organises Diabetes Week. The charity has a long history of campaigning; it was founded in 1934 by the writer H.G.Wells and Dr. R.D. Lawrence, who were themselves diabetics. The week is all about creating awareness of the condition and encouraging people to share their experiences of living with diabetes. Many other groups and organizations take part in diabetes week, hosting a wide variety of informative and fundraising events. 

Love your lungs week 21-27 June.



Individual journal titles are listed on the Internurse Homepage (to ensure you are in the Internurse database, select **'Collections'** at the top of the page and then select **'Internurse'**).

Once you have done this, you can choose from the available journals, e.g. **British Journal of Nursing**. This will take you directly to the most recent edition of that journal.

You can also search the archive of the journal by selecting **'Archive'** from the menu at the top.

You can search for keywords within a specific journal by using the **search box** in the top right-hand corner of the screen.

Enter your search term and click search. You will be presented with a list of articles from **this journal only**.



You can also search for articles across the **WHOLE** database by selecting 'Internurse' from the drop-down menu. Enter your **keywords** and click search.




Displaying, viewing & filtering results

Once you have searched for your keywords, you will be presented with a **list of articles** containing those

It tells you **how many** articles were

Click on the article title to expand the **ab-**

Open **more search options** to limit your results to specific **publication dates**, e.g. last year, or choose your own date



Sort the results by relevancy or publication date.

The **full reference** is provided for each article inc. author & pub date

Click on the **article title** to access the full text

You can **narrow your search** by using the **filters** at the left-hand side of the screen. Filter by publication date, author, keyword, publication (journal title). Use multiple filters at the same time, and remove them by clicking on **X** or

Sign up for a personal account and take advantage of these great features: **Save your favourite articles** for quick access; **Save your searches**; Get **content alerts of your favourite journals** delivered to you by email - simply visit the journal and click '**Subscribe**'.
