## SAFE EMAILS

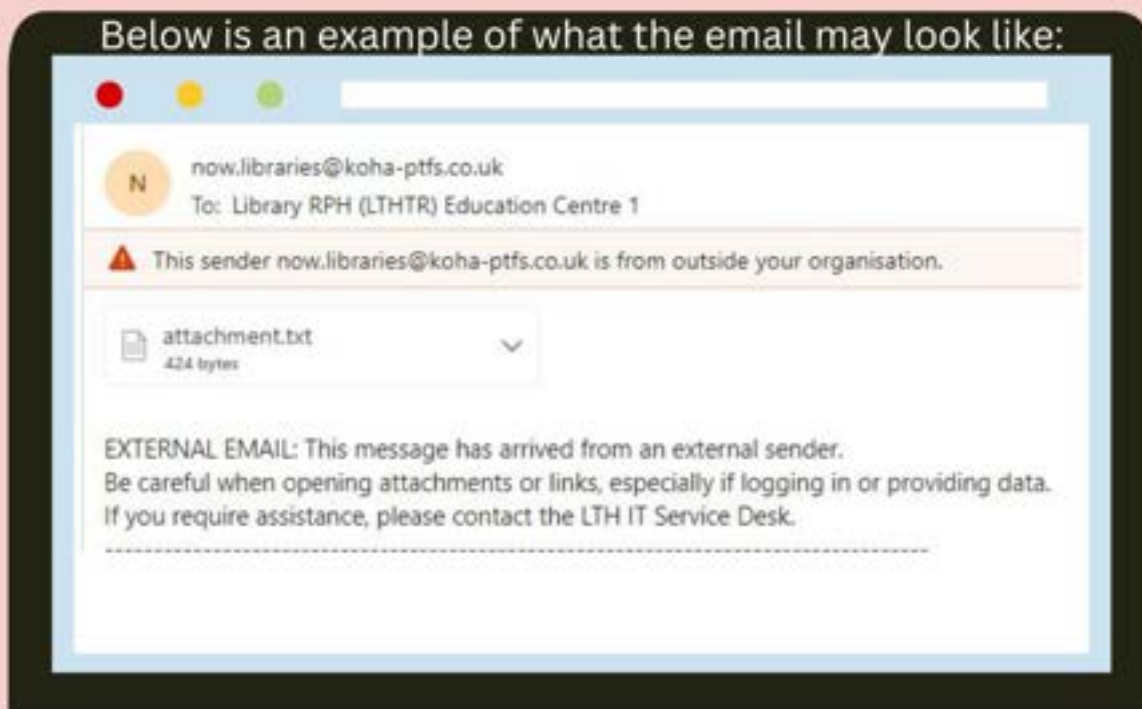
It is **safe** to open emails and attachments from the external email address:

- when a book is overdue
- when a book has automatically renewed
- if your account is expiring

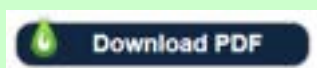
## Accessing articles online just got a whole lot easier!

LibKey Nomad browser extension gives you fast access to the Library's e-Journals when researching on resources like [PubMed](#).


Follow these instructions to set it up on your browser:

1. Go to the following website: <https://thirdiron.com/downloadnomad/>
2. Click on 'Get LibKey Nomad now'.
3. Select the browser you use (Select **Edge** if setting it up on a works PC)
4. Click on the button 'Get' .
5. Then select 'Add extension'.
6. A pop-up box will appear saying 'LibKey Nomad has been added to Microsoft Edge'. Close this box.
7. Now **select your organisation** by typing 'Lancashire Teaching Hospitals' in the box.

Once you have selected the organisation it is all set up and ready to go. Now when searching on PubMed look for links to download articles.
